⁽¹⁾ Fees per lot include 500 feet of line extension. Line extensions greater than the allowance will be charged at the applicable rate and will be in addition to the lot fee. If construction of the subdivision underground facilities has not begun within 12 months of the date of the fee payment, the per-lot fee shall be adjusted to the fee currently in effect and paid by the developer before construction begins. Fees for subdivisions may be updated, at the District's discretion, if construction has not begun within 12 months of the date of the fee payment.

⁽²⁾ Fee does not include the cost of the transformer but does include any labor associated with the installation or removal of the transformer.
