

REGULATION NO. 14

SHORTAGE OF ELECTRIC SUPPLY
AND INTERRUPTION OF DELIVERY

The District will exercise reasonable diligence and care to furnish and deliver a continuous and sufficient supply of electric energy to the customer and to avoid any shortage or interruption of delivery of same. The District will not be liable for interruption or shortage or insufficiency of supply.

The District, whenever it shall find it necessary for the purpose of making repairs or improvements to its system, will have the right to suspend temporarily the delivery of electric energy. The making of such repairs or improvements will be prosecuted as rapidly as may be practicable and, if practicable, at such time as will cause the least inconvenience to the customers affected. Wherever possible, as circumstances will permit, reasonable notice thereof will be given to the customers.

In case of shortage of supply and during the period of such shortage, the District will apportion its available supply of energy among all customers in the most reasonable manner possible to continue service equitably and without discrimination.
