

REGULATION NO. 2

CONNECTION CHARGE

- A. A connection charge for new construction shall be advanced by the applicant to the District prior to the installation of service facilities. The connection charge is for the running of wire from the primary distribution line to the customer's approved meter location and installing the meter for either overhead or underground service. This charge is nonrefundable and will be determined from acceptable final plans submitted to the District, Regulation No. 16, Meters and Service Extensions, and the current fee schedule. In some instances, the connection charge will be determined from nameplate ratings, through tests by the District or any other method determined by the District to be equitable.

- B. The connection charge applies to residential, residential subdivision and commercial/industrial/other accounts. The length (120 feet maximum), size of service and requirements for metering will be considered when determining whether the standard connection charge applies or whether the connection charge will be based on estimated costs.

- C. In addition to the connection charge, the service establishment charge (Regulation No. 2A) will be assessed.
