Mr. Allegranza currently serves as interim manager of Imperial Irrigation District's Energy Department where he plans and directs the essential functions of the department.

His duties include overseeing administration, regulatory policy, operations and energy infrastructure, resource planning, system and trading operations and generation to meet the district's strategic plan and the department's goals and objectives.

Mr. Allegranza has worked for IID for 25 years. During his tenure he has served in numerous capacities, including key leadership roles in the Energy Department as manager of department operations and deputy department manager. Most of his work, however, has been in service as chief information officer where his primary responsibilities were to plan, direct and coordinate the design, implementation and maintenance of the district's information technology systems.

Mr. Allegranza began his career at the district as a senior programmer in the Water Department after serving six years in the United States Navy and a short time as a software and test engineer. He became a computer systems engineer and network management supervisor in 1997 in IID's Information Systems Section. During his time at IID, he has served in the Energy Department's Telecommunications Section as senior engineer, Telecommunications superintendent and general superintendent before being named chief technology officer in 2013.
