



IID'S GREEN ENERGY RATE PROGRAM

Under Imperial Irrigation District's new Green Energy Rate Program, the district will purchase additional renewable energy from local renewable developers on the customers' behalf. Customers will purchase this renewable power at an option equal to 100 percent, or lower, of their electricity use.

WHY PARTICIPATE?

The Green Energy Rate Program complements IID's existing support for clean energy in the communities it serves. Enrolling in the Green Energy Rate Program will help make a difference in the community we live in by:

- *Providing clean energy for our future.*
- *Sharing in environmental responsibility.*
- *Reducing greenhouse gas emissions and contributing to a healthier environment.*
- *Providing options for customers.*

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE GREEN ENERGY RATE PROGRAM?

The program is voluntary and optional. It is available to all electric customers on a first-come, first-serve basis until IID reaches the 5-megawatt limit available under the program. IID's net metering, distributive self-generation and wholesale power customers are not eligible to participate.

IS THERE A PARTICIPATION COST?

In the Green Energy Rate Program you pay a little extra (estimated from 1.31 to 2.0 cents per kilowatt-hour) for renewable energy. The rate will fluctuate monthly and is based on IID's cost to purchase the energy.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

If you choose the 50 percent Green Energy Rate participation level, multiply 1.31 cents by the total number of monthly kilowatt-hours participated under the program to come up with the additional amount you would pay for the renewable energy.

For example:

- *For a monthly usage of 1,500 kilowatt-hours, multiply 750 kilowatt-hours (50 percent of your monthly usage) by .0131. This equals approximately \$9.83 extra each month you'd pay for renewable energy.*

HOW IS THE GREEN ENERGY RATE PROGRAM DIFFERENT FROM NET ENERGY METERING AND THE NET BILLING PROGRAM?

Although IID reached its cap under the NEM Program in early 2016 and that program is closed, customers under NEM and the Net Billing Program receive the benefits of the solar production directly, since the customer is the solar energy producer. Under the Green Energy Rate Program, another developer is producing the energy, so there is an additional cost to obtain the energy and deliver it to customers.

HOW SOON WILL MY ACCOUNT BE PLACED IN THE NEW PROGRAM?

Your account will be enrolled in the program on your next scheduled billing month following your enrollment confirmation. You will receive a letter from IID confirming your enrollment. You may change your subscription option once every 12 months.

DO I HAVE TO STAY IN THE PROGRAM FOR A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF TIME?

Participation in the Green Energy Rate Program is voluntary, with no length of time required to stay in the program. You can be asked to be removed from the program at any time without penalty. The change will become effective at the start of the next billing period after the date IID receives your request to exit the program.
