

SCHEDULE AL
OUTDOOR AREA LIGHTING SERVICE

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to service for outdoor area lighting service in areas other than public streets, roads and highways, furnished from dusk to dawn where this service can be supplied from existing secondary overhead facilities of the District of suitable voltage. Applicable to District-owned outdoor area lighting equipment mounted on District-owned poles.

MONTHLY RATE

Energy Cost Adjustment:

The kilowatt-hours, as determined above, are subject to an energy cost adjustment as provided in Schedule ECA and ECA-R.

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SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- A. Service shall generally be from dusk to dawn and will be considered as 4,190 hours per year or 349 hours per month.
- B. A written contract for a term of one year will be required when service is first established under this schedule on existing poles.
- C. A written contract for a term of four years will be required when service is first established under this schedule where the installation of a new pole is required.
- D. Pole charges will terminate where customer has received four years continuous service under this schedule or where the District utilizes pole for additional purposes.
- E. Customer desiring the District to install other than standard wood poles and equipment, shall pay, in addition to the above monthly pole charge (for four years continuous service) a nonrefundable amount equal to the difference between the installed cost of the standard wood poles and equipment. Poles above 35 feet would be considered non-standard and would be the responsibility of the customer. Facilities installed in connection with such agreements become and remain the sole property of the District.
- F. Service will not be furnished under this schedule where, in the opinion of the District, an undue hazard or expense will be involved because of locations, mounting height or other reason. The installation of outdoor area lighting equipment and facilities is contingent upon the District obtaining easements, rights of way, clearances and permits satisfactory to the District for the required poles, lines, equipment and facilities.
- G. High-pressure sodium vapor outdoor area light fixtures will be changed to LED fixtures at the discretion of the District and under normal maintenance. Fixture replacements will be made by attrition only and when it does not interfere with other work. The customer is responsible for the cost of the LED light fixture and installation when a replacement or if a higher lamp wattage is requested.
- H. Modifications or relocation requested by the customer of installation under this schedule shall be subject to approval from the District. The District will perform the requested modifications or relocation, provided the customer agrees to pay the entire cost.
- I. This service will be in accordance with the utility's specifications as to the equipment, installation, maintenance and operation.

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- J. Customer shall maintain adequate access for the District's standard equipment used in maintaining facilities and for installation of its facilities. The District reserves the right to collect additional maintenance costs due to obstructed access or other conditions preventing the District from maintaining its equipment with standard operating procedures.
- K. Outages will be reported by the customer. Lamp maintenance and repairs will be done during regular working hours as soon as reasonably possible after the customer has notified the District. Monthly bills will not be adjusted for reasons of any outages. Billing will be adjusted to accommodate any fixture size changes.
- L. The customer may cancel a contract by payment of the monthly bill, multiplied by the number of months remaining in the initial contract.
- M. At the discretion of the District, service furnished under the schedule will be discontinued at any location where overhead distribution lines supplying the service are subsequently converted to underground distribution.
- N. Vegetation management is the responsibility of the customer for installation of new lights or maintaining existing lights.
- O. Regulations Governing the Sale of Electric Energy: Service under this rate schedule is subject to the District's Regulations Governing the Sale of Electric Energy.
