RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION FEES**

Residential Subdivision services not listed below shall be subject to an estimated fee as determined by the District.

Special Conditions:

- A. Per-Lot: The per lot fee covers the cost of running the single-phase primary branch circuits to the transformer(s), including secondary wire to the secondary pull-box, the service wire to the home, and setting the meter.
- B. Distribution Line Extension Per-Foot: Based on the services requested, the per-foot fees applied per development may be a combination of the per foot fees outlined above.

Underground, Three-Phase Service, 600 Amp Distribution Line Extension Per-Foot:

Costs cover the required installation of 3-No. 750 Aluminum Concentric Neutral (ACN) Jacketed 15kV Cables operating at 7.2/12.5kV.

Underground, Three-Phase Service, 200 Amp Distribution Line Extension Per-Foot:

Costs cover the required installation of 3-No. 1/0 Aluminum Concentric Neutral Jacketed (ACN) Jacketed 15kV Cables operating at 7.2/12.5kV.

- C. Distribution Line Extension Allowance: Distribution line extensions shall receive a one-time 500 feet allowance per development. Line extensions greater than the allowance will be charged at the applicable per foot rate in addition to the per-lot fee.

If construction of the subdivision facilities has not begun within 12 months of the date of the fee payment, the fees shall be adjusted to the fee currently in effect.

The allowance credit shall be applied after distribution line extension charges are calculated for the proposed service. Allowance will be applied for either the 600 amp or 200 amp distribution line extension facilities, and not for both. The allowance will be applicable one-time per subdivision development.

- D. Transformer: Fees do not include the cost of the transformer, but do include any labor associated with the installation or removal of the transformer.
