

IID'S RECHARGE! EV CHARGER REBATE PROGRAM

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS



How to Apply

1. Before applying for a rebate through IID's **reCharge! EV Charger Rebate Program**, please be sure to read the Terms and Conditions, Supporting Documentation Requirements and all application instructions.
2. Confirm availability of rebate funds by contacting IID's Rebate Processing Center. Funding is limited and rebates are not guaranteed.
3. Purchase and install qualifying product between January 1, 2026, and December 31, 2026. Limit one (1) electric vehicle charger rebate per IID account.
4. Be sure to read and complete the online application at www.iid.com/recharge.
5. Collect supporting documentation. If submitting an invoice as proof of purchase and installation, the invoice must be itemized. (See Supporting Documentation Requirements below.)
6. Make copies of all documents for your records.
7. Submit your completed online application and supporting documentation at www.iid.com/recharge during the same calendar year as the purchase year of the EV Charger unit.
8. Rebates are limited and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

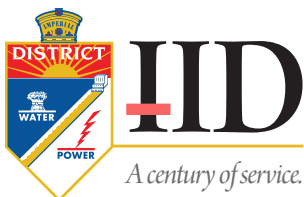
Supporting Documentation Requirements

When submitting an online application at www.iid.com/rebates, please ensure the following digital items are attached:

1. all charging station purchase and installation receipts;
2. a photo of the installed EV charging station; and
3. a photo of the serial number on your charger.

Program Limitations and Requirements

- **Rebate limit.** One rebate per charging station; dual-port charging stations are only eligible for a single rebate.
- **Maximum annual rebate.** Residential rebates are capped at \$5,000 annually per customer account for all rebate programs combined.
- **Rebate frequency.** A customer may only receive a rebate for the same product type once every five years.
- **Limited funding.** Rebates are limited, not guaranteed and may be terminated without prior notice.
- **Self-generating customers.** Self-generating customers' rebate amounts will be determined by the percentage of their total energy usage that is not offset by their photovoltaic system. For example, if only 25% of a self-generating customer's energy is supplied by IID, their incentive is reduced to 25% of the rebate amount listed on the application.
- **Self-installation.** Customers that self-install products do not need to work with a contractor, but must obtain any required permits from their local jurisdiction, if applicable.

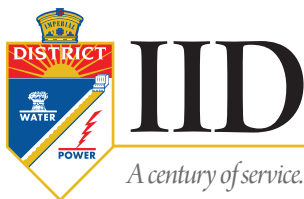

PART 1: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please read the Terms and Conditions carefully.

1. I understand that only electrical vehicle chargers that meet the Product Eligibility Requirements and are installed at a residence with an active IID electrical account are eligible for the IID ReCharge! EV Charger Rebate Program rebate.
2. I understand that funding is available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Funds are limited and rebates are not guaranteed. This program may be modified or terminated without prior notice.
3. I understand that Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EV charger) must be purchased and installed between January 1, 2026, and December 31, 2026. Limit one (1) EV charger rebate per account.
4. I understand that the equipment must be new and installed at the residence listed on this application prior to submittal of this application. Units that are resold, rebuilt, retrofitted, rented, awarded as a prize, received in full or in part from insurance claims or warranties or installed as a result of new construction do not qualify.
5. I understand that the online application with supporting documentation must be submitted online to the IID Rebate Processing Center no later than December 31, 2026.
6. I will allow, if requested, reasonable access to my residence to verify the installed item(s) noted on the online application. I understand that a rebate will not be paid or I will be invoiced for the rebate amount, if I refuse a verification inspection.
7. I agree that the selection, purchase, installation, ownership and maintenance of the product or improvement listed on the online application are my sole responsibility and that my supplier, installer or contractor who provided these product or improvement is not an agent or representative of IID. I also understand that, with respect to the EV charger I choose to install, IID makes no warranty, whether expressed or implied, including warranty of merchantability or fitness for any particular purpose. I agree that IID has no liability whatsoever concerning: (1) the EV charger I choose to install; and (2) the workmanship of any third parties. I agree that in no event shall IID's liability for property loss or damage resulting from its activities under this online application exceed the total rebate amount paid to me under this online application.
8. I understand that the rebate amount per unit will be paid according to the rebate amount per unit in effect at the time the application is received by IID.
9. If a tenant, I understand I am responsible for obtaining the property owner's permission to install the product or equipment for which I am applying for a rebate. By accepting the terms and conditions of the online application, I indicate I have obtained this permission.
10. I understand that the rebate amount cannot exceed 50% of the total net purchase price plus installation cost, where the net purchase price is defined as the documented purchase cost less any taxes, shipping, insurance coverage and incentives received from other entities (other than tax credits).
11. I understand that if I am a self-generating customer, my rebate amount will be determined by the percentage of my total energy usage that is provided by IID.
12. I understand that if my rebate is \$500 or less, IID may apply the rebate funds to my electrical account.
13. TAX LIABILITY—Rebates and incentives are taxable. You are urged to consult your tax advisor concerning the taxability of rebates. IID is not responsible for any taxes that may be imposed on you as a result of your receipt of this rebate.
14. I certify that I will comply with all program requirements and with all applicable local, state or federal laws and property owner and/or homeowner's association requirements, if any. In instances when a contractor is required for the installation of the new equipment, I understand it is my responsibility to ensure the contractor holds the appropriate license for the work performed.



PART 2: PRODUCT INFORMATION AND REBATE

Product Eligibility Requirements

Product	Requirements
EV Charger	EV Charger must be exclusively Level 2 (240 V) and utilize the J Plug (SAE J1772) connector or Tesla wall connector. Portable or 110V compatible units do not qualify. EV Charger must be wall or pedestal mounted. EV Charger must be UL listed or equivalent. EV Chargers with greater capacity will be considered on a case-by-case basis. EV Charger must be designed for DOT-approved electric vehicles (golf carts, neighborhood carts, motorcycles, electric scooters or bicycles and other lower-speed vehicles are not eligible). Product must be purchased and installed in 2026 in order to qualify for a rebate.

In order to qualify, please submit an online application at www.iid.com/recharge and attach the following to the online application:

1. A paid-in-full EV charger receipt (and installation invoice, if any).
2. A photo of the installed EV charger.
3. A photo of the serial number on your EV charger.
