

IMPERIAL IRRIGATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION NO. 38-2022

Certification of Candidates for the Runoff Election for Division 3 and Request to Consolidate the Runoff Election with the Statewide General Election to be held on November 8, 2022

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Elections Code sections 1000, 1001 and 1200, November 8, 2022 is the statewide general election date; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Uniform District Election Law, specifically California Elections Code section 10503, the Irrigation District Law shall govern first as the principal act, and when the Irrigation District Law contains no provisions on the election matter, the Uniform District Election Law shall govern, and when the Uniform District Election Law contains no provisions on the election matter, the general election laws under the California Elections Code shall govern; and

WHEREAS, California Water Code section 22970 provides that in an irrigation district containing 500,000 acres or more, which includes the Imperial Irrigation District, "when there are three or more candidates for an elective office and at the general district election no one candidate for the elective office secures a majority of the votes cast, a runoff election shall be held"; and

WHEREAS, California Water Code section 22970.10 provides that the IID Board of Directors shall certify the two candidates who received the highest number of votes for the elective office in the district general election held on June 7, 2022 as the candidates in the runoff election; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of Imperial County issued a *Certificate of Elections Results* for the general district election held on June 7, 2022 for the IID office of Director for Division 3, which indicates that no one candidate received a majority of the votes cast and identified the two candidates who received the highest number of votes; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the runoff election for the IID Director for Division 3 be consolidated with the statewide general election to be held on November 8, 2022 and, pursuant to Elections Code sections 10400 and 10401, the Imperial County Board of Supervisors may order the consolidation of the runoff election for IID with the statewide general election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Elections Code section 10507, the term of office for IID Director for Division 3 is four years and will expire in 2026; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Water Code section 22970.35 and California Elections Code section 10517, the Imperial County Registrar of Voters shall conduct the runoff election for IID; and

WHEREAS, IID desires to have its runoff election for IID Director, Division 3 held on November 8, 2022, conducted by the Imperial County and consolidated with the statewide general election held on that same date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as follows:

1. The Board of Directors hereby certify that Gina Young Dockstader and Don C. Campbell are the two candidates for the office of the Imperial Irrigation District Director, Division 3, in the runoff election as the two candidates with the highest number of votes cast in the June 7, 2022 general district election pursuant to the Imperial County's *Certificate of Election Results*.
2. The office of the Imperial Irrigation District Director for Division 3 will expire in 2022 and the Board of Directors hereby calls for the runoff election to be held on November 8, 2022 to fill this office. This office will be elected by division. Candidates will be responsible for the payment of publication of the statement of qualifications.
3. The Board of Directors hereby requests that the Imperial County Board of Supervisors order the consolidation of the IID runoff election with the statewide general election held on November 8, 2022 for the purpose of electing the IID Director office for Division 3.
4. The Board of Directors hereby acknowledges that the consolidated election will be held and conducted in the manner prescribed in California Elections Code section 10418.

5. Pursuant to California Elections Code sections 10509 and 10522, the Board of Directors hereby direct the secretary of the board to immediately deliver this resolution to the Imperial County Registrar of Voters by personal delivery and/or certified mail as notice of certification of the runoff election candidates, the calling of the runoff election and the request for consolidation of the election. The Imperial County Registrar of Voters has received all official maps of the district boundaries and the boundaries of Division 3.
