Proclaiming September as *Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month*

WHEREAS, almost 22,000 women are diagnosed with ovarian cancer in the United States every year, and about 14,000 lose their lives; and

WHEREAS, ovarian cancer is very treatable when detected early, currently 75 percent of new cases are not diagnosed until the disease is in its late stages of development, when treatment is less effective. With early detection, women have a survival rate of over 90 percent; diagnosis in its later stages, however, dramatically reduces the chances of survival to just 25 percent; and

WHEREAS, each year during **September**, women living with ovarian cancer, their families and supporters, along with patient advocacy organizations, come together to raise awareness about ovarian cancer; and


WHEREAS, Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month offers an opportunity to educate Americans about the symptoms and risk factors of the disease, to alert health care providers about the need for vigilance in recognizing those symptoms and risks early, and to promote increased funding for research into more effective methods of diagnosis and treatment in order that more women and their families can live out their lives free from the shadow of this devastating disease.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Imperial Irrigation District Board of Directors proclaims the month of September as ***Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month***.


